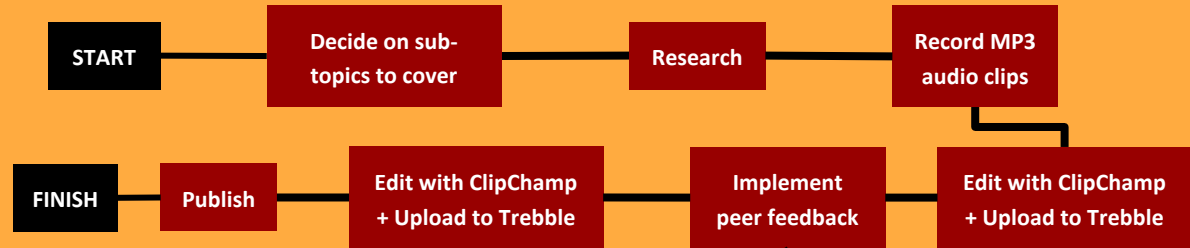
## Land Acknowledgement
