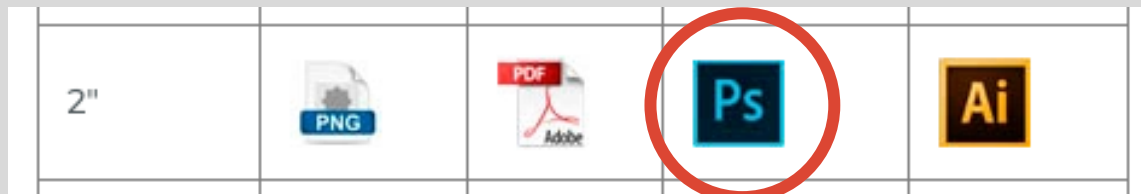


# HOW TO MAKE A BUTTON TEMPLATE

## STEP 1

Go to [ButtonMakers.net](https://buttonmakers.net).  
Select the "Design" tab then "Photoshop Templates".  
Download the 2" Photoshop zip file.



## STEP 2

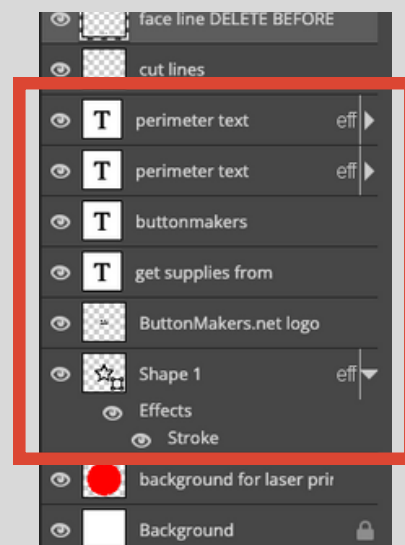
Go to [Photopea.com](https://photopea.com).  
Select "Open from Computer". Open the saved Photoshop file and select the "200.psd" document.



## STEP 3

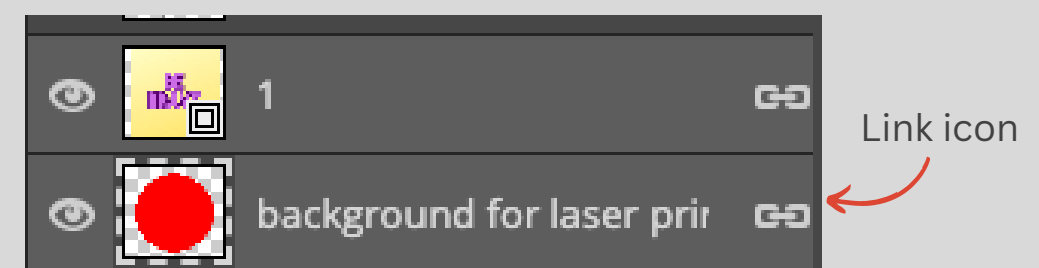
Use your Delete key to remove all the other layers shown here.

Go to the File tab and select "Open & Place". Select your button image.



## STEP 4

Make sure the button and background layers are one atop another. Select both layers, then select the Link icon located at the bottom of the panel. Once linked, select the Button layer, right-click and select "Clipping Mask". The image will fit the button.



## STEP 5

Select the Eye symbol to hide the "face line DELETE BEFORE" to hide the layer.



Go to the Edit tab, select "Define New" and "Pattern". Your button image will be saved.

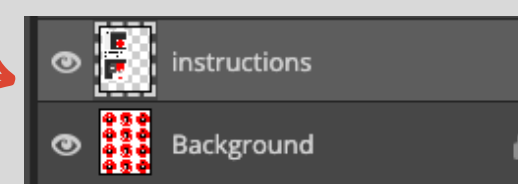


## STEP 6

Go to the File tab and "Open" the other zip file document.



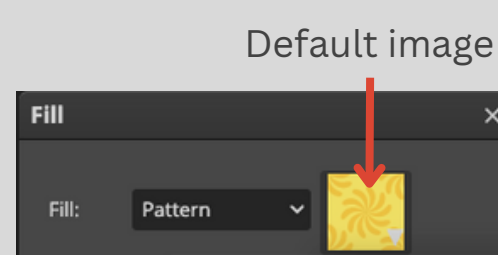
Delete or hide the Instructions layer.



## STEP 7

Under the Edit tab, go to "Fill" and from the dropdown select "Pattern". Click on the default image, find your button, then OK.

Your image should populate the multiple button page. Go to the File tab and export as a JPEG.



## STEP 8

To print the page, go to the File tab and select "New". Select the Print tab and choose 8.5 x 11" page size. Select "Create".

Go to the File tab, select "Open & Place" and choose the exported JPEG. Export the document in the file format of your choice.
