STEP 1

Go to ButtonMakers.net.

Select the "Design" tab then "Photoshop Templates".

Download the 2" Photoshop zip file.



STEP 3

Use your Delete key to remove all the other layers shown here.

Go to the File tab and select "Open & Place". Select your button image.

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STEP 2


Go to Photopea.com.

Select "Open from Computer". Open the saved Photoshop file and select the "200.psd" document.




STEP 4

Make sure the button and and background layers are one atop another. Select both layers, then select the Link icon located at the bottom of the panel. Once linked, select the Button layer, right-click and select "Clipping Mask". The image will fit the button.



STEP 5

Select the Eye symbol to hide the "face line DELETE BEFORE" to hide the layer.





Go to the Edit tab, select "Define New" and "Pattern". Your button image will be saved.



STEP 7

Under the Edit tab, go to "Fill" and from the dropdown select "Pattern". Click on the default image, find your button, then OK.








STEP 6 Go to the File tab and

"Open" the other zip file document.
