

## Find an Article by Topic in LibrarySearch

To find articles on a topic, type the keywords into the LibrarySearch box on the library homepage. For this example, I will type the keywords antiracism AND education. Select the magnifying glass or press enter to search.

Once I have a set of results, I can use the filters on the left side to refine and narrow my results. In this case, I will use the "Online" filter and the "Articles" filter, since I know I only want articles for this project, and then I'll select apply filters.

From here, I can browse through my results. In this view I see the title of the article, the name of the authors, the name of the Journal that the article was published in, and then also a snippet of the abstract. To view the whole abstract, I would click on the title and scroll down to the details section, where in most cases there will be a full abstract for me to read. Once I've determined that I want to see the full text of an article, I would select the "Download PDF" link or "Available Online" link. You'll have to log in with your UTORid and password in order to view the full text. We also recommend signing in with your UTORid and password into the LibrarySearch platform itself so that you can save searches and results for future reference. Happy searching.
